## Minutes of Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Wilson at 1500 hrs.

### **Order of Business:**

A quorum was present

A meeting of the Board was requested by Ms. Johnnetta Davis-Joyce from the Pacific Institute for Research and Evaluation (PIRE) to discuss the NLLEA/PIRE planning session for the upcoming annual training and underage drinking leadership program.

Ms. Davis-Joyce explained that she has received authority from OJJDP to a conduct quarterly executive forum for law enforcement leaders, managers and researchers on the status of underage drinking problems nationally. Ms. Davis-Joyce described the proposal as a discussion of the latest and greatest issues confronting underage alcohol use.

The proposal calls for co-hosting quarterly luncheons in Washington, D.C for Executive Directors, Presidents and staffers of national law enforcement organizations such as IACP, NOBLE, etc. In consideration for the partnership, NLLEA would assume a leadership role in the luncheon but not incur any financial liability.

All the individuals on the call seemed to feel this was a wonderful opportunity for NLLEA to achieve a more significant leadership role within the national law enforcement community on the issues surrounding underage alcohol use. Based upon this consensus Sec/Tres. Aidan Moore made a motion:

**Motion:** Aidan Moore motions that the NLLEA should accept this offer made by PIRE, and approved by OJJDP, to co-host quarterly law enforcement forums (luncheons) in the Washington, DC area.
